--- TASTING NOTES

Colour: Garnet red with vivid red highlights.

Nose: Blackcurrant, cherry, strawberry, liquorice, with hints of bilberry and pepper.

Palate: Fresh, marked by a fine minerality. Crunchy tannins and a beautiful fruity volume.

--- SERVING

Food Pairings Rillettes, warm pâté en croûte. Poultry in sauce, coq au vin, œufs en meurette, lamb cutlets, pork ribs with lentils.

Temperature 14–16 °C
