--- TASTING NOTES

Colour: Bright ruby.

Nose: Redcurrant and fresh cherry. With age: gentle spices and stewed prune.

Palate: Fresh on the attack, warming on the finish. Concentration and complexity expressed with delicacy. A precocity that allows for early opening — one seems to bite into the fruit and breathe in its flesh.

Food Pairings Duck breast with cherries, cep risotto, wild mushroom dishes.

Temperature 13–15 °C
